A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 64°00' E., 34.0 ft. dist.,
mkd. L S-3 - J C-2-883 BT.

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N. 8°40' W., 22.0 ft. dist.,
mkd. L S-3 - J C-2-883 BT.

Thence N. 65°01' E.

Descend northerly slope.

1370.00 Deadman Creek, 12 ft. wide, flows E. Ascend S. slope.

1476.00 Trail, bears E. and W.

1479.10 Cor. No. 4.

Drove an iron pin, 8 ins. long, 5/8 ins. diam., 7 ins. in conglomerate bedrock, for Cor. No. 4, and chisel in bedrock L S-4-883; from which

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 4°05' E., 22.3 ft. dist.,
mkd. L S-4-883 BT.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 80°25' W., 75.0 ft. dist.,
mkd. L S-4-883 BT.

Thence S. 24°09' E.

Descend south slope.

1.00 Trail, bears E. and W.

30.00 Deadman Creek, 12 ft. wide, flows E.; ascend north slope.

300.00 Lode line; discovery point bears S. 65°01' W., 1469.10 ft. dist.

450.00 Top of spur, slopes N. 80°00' E.; descend southeasterly slope.

600.00 Cor. No. 1, and place of beginning.

Set a basalt boulder, 24 x 12 x 8 ins., 18 ins. in the ground, surrounded by a mound of stone to top, for Cor. No. 1, mkd. B E E-1-883; from which

The cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35, T. 29 S., R. 2 W., W. M.,
bears N. 44°46'26" E., 754.89 ft. dist.

A yew, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 4°15' W., 25.5 ft. dist.,
mkd. B E E-1-883 BT.

A hemlock, 36 ins. diam., bears N. 66°30' E., 26.1 ft. dist.,
mkd. B E E-1-883 BT.

Thence S. 65°01' W.

Ascend easterly slope.

1500.00 Cor. No. 2.

Set a basalt boulder, 27 x 16 x 6 ins., 18 ins. in the ground, surrounded by a mound of earth, for Cor. No. 2, mkd. B E E-2-B-2-883; from which

A tan oak, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 80°50' W., 25.8 ft. dist.,
mkd. B E E-2-B-2-883 BT.

A white fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 11°00' E., 36.5 ft. dist.,
mkd. B E E-2-B-2-883 BT.
