600.00	Cor. No. 2. Set a basalt boulder, 24 x 14 x 5 ins., 18 ins. in the ground, surrounded by a mound of stone to top, for Cor. No. 2, mkd. U B S-2-U B-4-883; from which A maple, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 13°25' E., 16.3 ft. dist., mkd. U B S-2-U B-4-883 BT. A white fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 89°15' W., 18.5 ft. dist., mkd. U B S-2-U B-4-883 BT. Thence S. 67°06' W. Ascend southeasterly slope.

1500.00	Cor. No. 3. Set a basalt boulder, 24 x 11 x 9 ins., 18 ins. in the ground, surrounded by a mound of stone to top, for Cor. No. 3, mkd. U B S-3-883; from which A pine, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 78°45' E., 28.1 ft. dist., mkd. U B S-3-883 BT. A pine, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 63°00' E., 28.5 ft. dist., mkd. U B S-3-883 BT. Thence N. 24°09' W. Descend northwesterly slope.
300.00	Lode line; discovery point bears N. 67°06' E., 1495 ft. dist.
600.00	Cor. No. 4. Set a basalt boulder, 24 x 18 x 9 ins., 18 ins. in the ground, surrounded by a mound of stone to top, for Cor. No. 4, mkd. U B S-4-883; from which A fir, 23 ins. diam., bears N. 70°45' E., 48.6 ft. dist., mkd. U B S-4-883 BT. A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S. 42°50' E., 46.4 ft. dist., mkd. U B S-4-883 BT. Thence N. 67°06' E. Ascend northwesterly slope.
485.00	Spur of ridge, slopes N.; descend easterly slope.
735.50	Cor. No. 1, Queen lode of this survey. Along northwesterly slope.
1285.50	Ridge, course N. 10° E. and S. 40° W.; descend southeasterly slope.
1500.00	Cor. No. 1, and place of beginning.
