No. 1.	The discovery cut of the Bonanza East Extension lode, the mouth of which being the discovery point, is on the lode line, 360 ft. from the center of line 2-3; 10 ft. wide, 8 ft. face, runs S. 65°01' W. 10 ft. to face. Value, \$75.
