- No. 1 The discovery tunnel of the Elsie lode, 5 x 7 ft. in size, the portal of which being the discovery point, is on the lode line, 20 ft. from the center of line 1-2, running S. 50° W., 40.0 ft.; thence N. 40° W., 15 ft.; thence S. 60° W., 40.0 ft. to cave in. Tunnel is timbered.

- No. 2 A cut, the mouth of which bears S. 71°30' W., 650.0 ft. from Cor. No. 2, Elsie lode; 8 ft. wide, 8 ft. face, runs S. 23° E., 15 ft. to face.

- No. 1 The discovery cut of the Orbie lode, the mouth of which being the discovery point, is on the lode line, 200.0 ft. from the center of line 1-2; 7 ft. wide, 6 ft. face, runs N. 67° E., 14 ft. to face.

- No. 1 The discovery cut of the Granada lode, the mouth of which being the discovery point, is on the lode line, 500.0 ft. from the center of line 1-2; 25 ft. wide, 6 ft. face, runs N. 60° W., 8 ft. to face.

- No. 1 The discovery cut of the Granada SW. lode, the mouth of which being the discovery point, is on the lode line, 100.0 ft. from the center of line 3-4; 18 ft. wide, 5 ft. face, runs S. 67° W., 6 ft. to face.

- No. 1 The discovery cut of the Queen lode, the mouth of which being the discovery point, is on the lode line, 215.0 ft. from the center of line 1-2; 18 ft. wide, 4 ft. face, runs N. 67° E., 6 ft. to face.

- No. 1 The discovery cut of the Uncle Billy SW. lode, the mouth of which being the discovery point, is on the lode line, 5.0 ft. from the center of line 1-2; 7 ft. wide, runs S. 74° W., 15 ft. to portal of tunnel, 5 x 7 ft. in size, running S. 74° W., 12.0 ft. to breast.
Value of cut and tunnel, \$330.
- No. 2 A cut, the mouth of which bears S. 14° E., 180.0 ft. from Cor. No. 1 of the Uncle Billy SW. lode; 4 ft. wide, 5 ft. face, runs N. 65° W., 25.0 ft. to face.
Value, \$60.
- No. 3 A cut, the mouth of which bears S. 20° E., 140.0 ft. from Cor. No. 1 of the Uncle Billy SW. lode; 5 ft. wide, 5 ft. face, runs N. 73° W., 12.0 ft. to face.
Value, \$50.
- No. 1 The discovery cut of the Uncle Billy lode, the mouth of which being the discovery point, is on the lode line, 190.0 ft. from the center of line 2-3; 7 ft. wide, 7 ft. face, runs N. 67° E. 14.0 ft. to face.
Value, \$50.

An interest in a common improvement described as follows:

A tunnel, 5 x 7 ft. in size, the portal of which bears N. 57°30' E., 210 ft. from Cor. No. 2 of the Orbie lode; running S. 10° W., 120.0 ft.; thence S. 10° E., 210.0 ft. to pt. A; thence S. 70° E., 45.0 ft. to pt. B; thence N. 20° E., 35.0 ft.; thence N. 60° E., 39.0 ft. to pt. C, and 95.0 ft. to breast. At pt. A a drift, 5 x 7 ft. in size, runs S. 30° W., 30 ft.; thence S. 60° W., 27 ft. to Sta. 1, 42 ft. to Sta. 2, 52 ft. to Sta. 3, 55 ft. to Sta. 4, 140 ft. to Sta. 5, and 165 ft. to beginning of cave in. At Sta. 1 an ore chute, 5 x 7 ft. in size, extends vertically upward 30 ft., thence S. 60° W., 15 ft. to connect with a timbered shaft, 8 x 12 ft. in size, extending vertically upward 30 ft. from Sta. 2.
