No. 1

The discovery cut of the Maud S No. 3 lode, the center of which being the discovery point, is on the lode line, 350 ft. from the center of line 3-4; 10 ft. wide, 12 ft. long, 6 ft. deep; long sides bear S. 20° W. and N. 20° E.
Value, \$60.

No. 1

The discovery cut of the Maud S No. 2 lode, the mouth of which being the discovery point, is on the lode line, 380 ft. from the center of line 2-3; 12 ft. wide, 6 ft. face, runs S. 20° W., 10 ft. to face.
Value, \$50.

No. 1

The discovery cut of the Maud S East Extension No. 7 lode, the mouth of which being the discovery point, is on the lode line, 320 ft. from the center of line 2-3; 5 ft. wide, 6 ft. face, runs S. 65° W., 20 ft. to face.
Value, \$60.

An interest in common improvement described as follows:

A tunnel, 5 x 7 ft. in size, the portal of which bears N. 81° W., 370 ft. from Cor. No. 2 of the Maud S lode; tunnel is caved in at the portal, but an old map in possession of the claimant herein shows the tunnel length to be 379 ft. with an additional stope and a caved drift. The evidences of waste material sustain the claim made for this improvement and the said claimant is ready to offer witnesses as to the truth of such improvement.
Value of tunnel and stope, \$10,000.
Value of 1/10 interest, \$1,000.

This improvement is in course of construction for the development of the Maud S No. 1, Maud S, Maud S No. 5, Maud S West Extension No. 8, Maud S West Extension No. 9, Maud S West Extension No. 10, Maud S No. 4, Maud S No. 3, Maud S No. 2 and Maud S East Extension No. 7 lodes of this survey, which are all contiguous lode claims owned in common within the range of benefit of said improvement.

The ground surface rises easterly and southerly from the portal of the tunnel, and the extension of the tunnel, with the necessary laterals, affords a possible means of developing each of the stated lodes.

Five hundred dollars or over has been expended in this improvement in such a manner as tends to the development of each of the lodes just hereinbefore mentioned as sharing in the benefit of this common improvement subsequent to its location and to the time since which common ownership and contiguity have prevailed; therefore an undivided one-tenth interest in its value is hereby credited to each of said lodes.

No portion of or interest in this improvement has been credited heretofore as patent expenditure to any lode claim.

OTHER IMPROVEMENTS

A frame mill building, the most southerly corner of which bears N. 17°00' E., 360 ft. from Cor. No. 2 of the Orbie lode; 17.0 x 98.0 ft. in size; the long sides bear N. 20°00' E.; at 23.0 ft. from the southwesterly corner of the building, the southerly line of a condensing structure, 11.0 ft. wide, joins the mill building and extends N. 70°00' W., 50.0 ft.
Claimant herein.

A frame wood shed, the most southerly corner of which bears N. 13°30' W., 145.0 ft. from Cor. No. 2, Orbie lode; 16.0 x 19.0 ft. in size; the long sides bear N. 11°45' E.
Claimant herein.

A frame store house, the most southerly corner of which bears North, 160 ft. from Cor. No. 2, Orbie lode; 16.3 x 14.5 ft. in size; the long sides bear N. 78°15' W.
Claimant herein.
