A frame bunk house, the most southerly corner of which bears N. 1°00' E., 220 ft. from Cor. No. 2, Orbie lode; 14 x 17 ft. in size; the long sides bear N. 78°15' W.

A frame barn, the most southerly corner of which bears N. 9°30' W., 294.0 ft. from Cor. No. 2, Orbie lode; 24 x 37 ft. in size; the long sides bear N. 15°00' W.

Claimant herein.

A frame bunk house, the most southerly corner of which bears N. 24°15' E., 112.0 ft. from Cor. No. 2, Orbie lode; 12 x 36 ft. in size; the long sides bear N. 78°15' W.

Claimant herein.

A frame power plant building, the most southerly corner of which bears N. 50°00' E., 230 ft. from Cor. No. 2, Orbie lode; 24 x 26 ft. in size; the long sides bear N. 52°00' E.

Claimant herein.

A frame machine shop, the most southerly corner of which bears N. 58°50' E., 234 ft. from Cor. No. 2, Orbie lode; 16 x 48 ft. in size; the long sides bear N. 20°00' E.

Claimant herein.

A log cabin, the most easterly corner of which bears N. 28°30' W., 100 ft. from Cor. No. 2, Granada lode; 12 x 22 ft. in size; the long sides bear S. 60°00' W.

Claimant herein.

A cook house, the most southerly corner of which bears N. 10°00' W., 172 ft. from Cor. No. 2, Orbie lode; 12 x 50 ft. in size; the long sides bear N. 78°15' W.

Claimant herein.

A bunk house, the most southerly corner of which bears N. 61°30' W., 240 ft. from Cor. No. 3, Maud S East Extension No. 7 lode; 15 x 18 ft. in size; the long sides bear N. 47°30' W.

Claimant herein.

A cook house, the most easterly corner of which bears N. 75°00' W., 308 ft. from Cor. No. 2, Maud S No. 1 lode; 24.5 x 37.0 ft. in size; the long sides bear S. 42°30' W.

Claimant herein.

A frame mill building, the northeast corner of which bears S. 83°30' W., 545 ft. from Cor. No. 2, Maud S No. 1 lode; 20 x 37 ft. in size; the long sides bear N. and S.

Claimant herein.

A frame house, the northeast corner of which bears S. 79°00' W., 632 ft. from Cor. No. 2, Maud S No. 1 lode. Beginning at the northeast corner, the boundaries of the house are as follows: South, 24 ft.; thence West, 24 ft.; thence North, 12 ft.; thence East, 12 ft.; thence North, 12 ft.; thence East, 12 ft. to beginning.

An ore chute, the most easterly corner of which bears N. 80°30' W., 375 ft. from Cor. No. 2, Maud S lode; 8 x 45 ft. in size; the long sides bear S. 10°15' E.

OTHER CORNER DESCRIPTIONS

A tie line was run from Cor. No. 3, Granada SW. lode to the sec. cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34, T. 29 S., R. 2 W., W. M., and the sec. cor. was found to bear N. 41°25'30" W., 933.72 ft. dist. The sec. cor. is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, with brass cap mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

The location corners are wood posts.
