LOCATION

This survey is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 33, T. 32 S., R. 4 W. of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon.

The survey of the Gold Leaf lode and the North Extension Gold Leaf lode is wholly within the amended location as marked on the ground. Cors. Nos. 1, 2 and 4 of the Gold Leaf lode are identical with the corners of the location; Cor. No. 3 differs to the extent previously shown. Cors. Nos. 3 and 4 of the North Extension Gold Leaf lode are identical with corners of the location; Cors. Nos. 1 and 2 differ to the extent previously shown.

EXPENDITURES

The improvements and the value of the labor and improvements made upon or for the benefit of each of the lode locations embraced in said mining claim by the claimant or its grantors are as follows:

- No. 1 The discovery cut of the Gold Leaf lode, the face of which being the discovery point, is on the lode line, S. 11°45' W., 61.01 ft. from a point on line 1-2, 297.27 ft. from Cor. No. 1; 8 ft. wide, 8 ft. face, runs S. 10°00' W., 10 ft. to face and portal of tunnel 6 x 7 ft. in size, running S. 10°00' W., 76 ft.; thence S. 5°00' E., 75.0 ft. to breast.
Value, \$3000.00.
- No. 2 A tunnel, 5 x 7 ft. in size, the portal of which bears S. 50°40' E., 319.31 ft. from Cor. No. 1 Gold Leaf lode, and runs S. 10°00' W., 30 ft. to point A, 47.0 ft. to point B, 71.0 ft. to point C, 77.0 ft. to point D, and 118 ft. to Sta. 1; thence S. 20° E., 35.0 ft. to breast. At point A, a drift, 5 x 7 ft. in size, runs S. 28°00' W., 41.0 ft. to cross-cut. At point B, a stope 15 x 20 x 5 ft. At point C, a cross-cut 5 x 7 ft. in size, running
