## AREAS

Total area, Hard Times lode ----- Acres

## LOCATION

This survey is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , and SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 12, T. 33 S., R. 5 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon.

The survey of the Hard Times lode is entirely within the location as marked on the ground; corner No. 4 is identical with a corner of the location; corners Nos. 1, 2, and 3 differ to the extent previously shown.

## EXPENDITURES

The improvements and the value of the labor and improvements made upon or for the benefit of the lode location embraced in this mining claim by the claimant or his grantors are as follows:

- No. 1 The discovery cut of the Hard Times lode, the face of which being the discovery point, is on the lode line 50 ft. from a point on line 2-3, 300 ft. from Cor. No. 2; 5 ft. wide, 7 ft. face, runs N. 45° E., 16 ft. to face; at 13.5 ft. center of shaft, 5 ft. diam., 4 ft. deep.  
Value of cut and shaft, \$150.
- No. 2 A caved tunnel, 5 x 7 ft. in size, the portal of which bears S. 40° W., 665 ft. from Cor. No. 2 Hard Times lode, with exposed cavein running South, 20 ft.  
Value of exposed cavein, \$200.00
- No. 3 A cut, the mouth of which bears S. 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 233 ft. from Cor. No. 2 Hard Times lode, 5 ft. wide, runs S. 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 16 ft. to face, 9 ft. high, and portal of partially timbered tunnel, 5 x 7 ft. in size, running S. 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 57 ft. to breast.  
Value of cut and tunnel, \$1550.
- No. 4 A cut, the mouth of which bears N. 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 273 ft. from Cor. No. 3 Hard Times lode, 6 ft. wide, runs N. 40° E., 26 ft. to face, 6 ft. high.  
Value, \$200.00
- No. 5 A cut, the mouth of which bears N. 89°55' W., 628 ft. from Cor. No. 3 Hard Times lode, 15 ft. wide, runs S. 22° E., 66 ft. to face, 20 ft. high.  
Value, \$800.00

## OTHER IMPROVEMENTS

A log cabin, the SE. corner of which bears S. 66° W., 466 ft. from Cor. No. 3 Hard Times lode, 12 x 21 ft. in size; the long sides bear S. 66° W.  
Claimant herein.

An un-housed two stamp mill, the center of which bears N. 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 499 ft. from Cor. No. 4 Hard Times lode.  
Claimant herein.

## SUPPLEMENTAL DATA

The placer work shown along line 1-2 of the Hard Times lode is the work of James Beckwith, post office address, Azalea, Oregon. There is no location certificate for such a placer claim recorded in the official records of Douglas County, Oregon. After an exhaustive search, I fail to find any location corners or location notice for such a placer claim.

The Forgetmenot lode claim (unsurveyed) presumably joins the easterly end of the Hard Times lode. I find none of the corners to be identical and there is no conflict.
