LOCATION

This survey is located in the NE., NW. and SW. quarters of sec. 7, T. 32 S., R. 2 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon.

The survey of the Emma and Amy No. 1 lode, Emma and Amy No. 2 lode and Emma and Amy Mill Site is wholly within the location as marked on the ground. Cors. Nos. 1, 2 and 4 of the Emma and Amy No. 1 lode; cors. Nos. 1 and 2 of the Emma and Amy No. 2 lode and cors. Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Emma and Amy Mill Site are identical with corners of the location. Cor. No. 3 of the Emma and Amy No. 1 lode and cors. Nos. 3 and 4 of the Emma and Amy No. 2 lode differ to the extent previously shown.

- No. 1 The discovery cut of the Emma and Amy No. 1 lode, the face of which being the discovery point, is on the lode line, 782.44 ft. S. 40°25'30" W., from a point on line 1-2, 288.27 ft. from Cor. No. 1; 8 ft. wide, 8 ft. face, running S. 40°30' W., 15.0 ft. to face and portal of tunnel which is so badly caved that its extent is not measurable.

- No. 2 A trench, the NW. end of which bears S. 2°38' W., 485.0 ft. from Cor. No. 1 Emma and Amy No. 1 lode; 6 ft. wide, 6 ft. deep, running S. 20° W., 30 ft.
Value, \$250.00.
- No. 3 An open cut, the S. end of which bears S. 28°35' E., 215.0 ft. from Cor. No. 1 Emma and Amy No. 1 lode; 8 ft. wide, 20 ft. deep, running South, 30.0 ft.
Value, \$500.00.
- No. 1 The discovery cut of the Emma and Amy No. 2 lode, the center of which being the discovery point, is on the lode line, 382.44 ft. N. 40°25'30" E., from a point on line 1-2, 288.27 ft. from Cor. No. 1; 15 ft. wide, 15 ft. deep, running N. 40°25'30" E., 8 ft. to face.
Value of cut, \$200.00.
- No. 2 An open cut, immediately above the discovery cut, the SW. end of which bears N. 72°17' E., 477.0 ft. from Cor. No. 1 Emma and Amy No. 2 lode; 8 ft. wide, 10 ft. deep, running N. 40°25'30" E., 20 ft. to face.
Value of cut, \$200.00.
- No. 3 A tunnel; timbered and caved; 5 x 7 ft. in size, the portal of which bears N. 84°32' E., 462.0 ft. from Cor. No. 1 Emma and Amy No. 2 lode, runs N. 55° W., 50.0 ft. to cave in.
Value of tunnel, \$2500.00.
