CHAINS

- 13.62 A dry ravine, course N.
- 21.45 A dry ravine, course N.
- 23.26 To Cor. No. 3, identical with Cor. W.H. 14 of listing survey, a stake mkd. and witnessed as described by Peter S. Rice, Assistant Ranger and Surveyor; in place of which I set a sandstone, 24 x 12 x 6 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, for Cor. 3, mkd. 3 H E S 129 on N. face, with a cross (X) on top; from which
- An alder, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 56°50' E., 18 lks. dist.,
- An alder, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 38°15' W., 21 lks. dist.,
 both trees blazed and scribed 3 H E S 129 BT.
- Land, mountainous.
 Timber, fir and alder.
 Soil, 2nd rate.
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- Thence
- N. 80°46' E., on true line to Cor. 4.
- Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
 Continue along foot of mountain.
- 11.70 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course NW.
- 14.59 To Cor. No. 4, identical with Cor. W.H. 13 of listing survey, a stake mkd. and witnessed as described by Peter S. Rice, Assistant Ranger and Surveyor, in place of which I set a sandstone, 24 x 18 x 10 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, for Cor. 4, mkd. 4 H E S 129 on NW. face, with a cross (X) on top; from which
- A maple, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 55°00' E., 38 lks. dist.,
- A maple, 38 ins. diam., bears N. 51°00' W., 102 lks. dist.,
 both trees blazed and scribed 4 H E S 129 BT.
- Land, mountainous.
 Timber, fir, alder and maple.
 Soil, 2nd rate.
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- Thence
- N. 0°40' E., on true line to Cor. 5.
- Over rolling bottom land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
 Leave mountainous and enter rolling land at Cor. 4, bears E. and W.
- 1.00 Harvey Creek, 50 lks. wide, course NW. (Creek dry.)
- 3.72 To Cor. No. 5, on S. side of road exemption.
 temp.
 In place of stake, I set a sandstone, 24 x 14 x 5 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, for Cor. 5, mkd. 5 H E S 129 on SW. face, with a cross (X) on top; from which
- A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 87°30' E., 48 lks. dist.,
- A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 12°45' W., 21 lks. dist.,
 both trees blazed and scribed 5 H E S 129 BT.
- Land, rolling.
 Timber, fir, alder and maple.
 Soil, 1st rate.
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
