	Over level land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

13.10	Fence, bears NW. and SE.
16.27	To Cor. No. 10, on N. side of road exemption.
	In place of temp. stake, I set a sandstone, 24 x 10 x 8 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, for Cor. 10, mkd. 10 H E S 129 on N. face, with a cross (X) on top; from which
	A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 17°45' E., 147 lks. dist.,
	A maple, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 39°00' E., 114 lks. dist., both trees blazed and scribed 10 H E S 129 BT.
	Land, level.
	Timber, fir, cedar, maple and alder.
	Soil, 1st rate.

	S. 74°42' E., on true line to Cor. 11, along N. side of road exemption, parallel to and 30.3 lks. right angle dist. from line 6-7, H.E.S. 129, Tract A.
	Over level cultivated land.
6.10	Fence, bears NE. and SW.
9.50	Leave cultivation and enter heavy timber and dense undergrowth, bears N. and S.
11.90	Dry wash, course SW.
18.40	Dry wash, course SW.
27.30	Harvey Creek, 40 lks. wide, course SW.
28.02	To Cor. No. 11, on N. side of road exemption.
	In place of temp. stake, I set a sandstone, 30 x 16 x 8 ins., 20 ins. in the ground, for Cor. 11, mkd. 11 H E S 129 on N. face, with a cross (X) on top; from which
	A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 79°30' E., 53 lks. dist.,
	A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N. 3°00' W., 2½ lks. dist., both trees blazed and scribed 11 H E S 129 BT.
	Land, level.
	Timber, fir, cedar, maple and alder.
	Soil, 1st rate.

	Thence
	N. 84°00' E., on true line to Cor. 12, along N. side of road exemption, parallel to and 30.3 lks. right angle dist. from line 5-6 H.E.S. 129, Tract A.
	Over level land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
