An alder, 10 ins. diam., bears East, 3 lks. dist.,

An alder, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 64°30' W., 6½ lks. dist.,  
 both trees blazed and scribed 21 H E S 129 BT.

Land, rolling.  
 Timber, fir, maple and alder.  
 Soil, 2nd rate.

Thence

N. 60°00' W., on true line to Cor. 22.

Over mountainous land, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.

Leave rolling and enter mountainous land at cor., bears NE. and SW.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 79°45' E., 45 lks. dist.,

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 40°45' W., 26 lks. dist.,  
 both trees blazed and scribed 22 H E S 129 BT.

 Soil, 3rd rate.
