To Cor. No. 7, identical with Cor. No. 15 of listing survey, which I destroy and in its place

Set a sandstone, 24 x 20 x 4 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over a stone marked with a cross for Cor. No. 7 of this survey, marked 7 HES 130 on side facing the claim; from which

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 88°30' E., 50 lks. dist., marked X 7 HES 130 BT.

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 20°00' E., 66 lks. dist., marked X 7 HES 130 BT.

Thence I sight Cor. No. 14 of listing survey, and run

N. 40°30' E., on a true line.

Over mountainous land, through heavy fir, cedar, maple and alder timber and dense undergrowth.

To Cor. No. 8, identical with Cor. No. 14 of listing survey, which I destroy and in its place

Set a sandstone, 30 x 26 x 12 ins., 20 ins. in the ground, over a stone marked with a cross for Cor. No. 8 of this survey, marked 8 HES 130 on side facing the claim; from which

A maple, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 86°45' E., 23 lks. dist., marked X 8 HES 130 BT.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 58°15' W., 38 lks. dist., marked X 8 HES 130 BT.

A maple, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 83°00' W., 26 lks. dist., marked X 8 HES 130 BT.

Thence I sight the temporary stake set on E. side of road exemption for Cor. No. 9 of this survey, and run

N. 49°15' W., on a true line, along bdy. line of list No. 6-683.

Descend over broken land, through heavy fir, cedar, alder and maple timber and dense undergrowth.

Harvey Creek, 55 lks. wide, course SW.; leave broken land, enter level land.

To Cor. No. 9, on E. side of road exemption. In place of temporary stake

Set a sandstone, 24 x 12 x 6 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over a stone marked with a cross for Cor. No. 9 of this survey, marked 9 HES 130 on side facing the claim; from which

A maple, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 87°15' E., 89 lks. dist., marked X 9 HES 130 BT.

A cedar, 40 ins. diam., bears S. 71°25' E., 59 lks. dist., marked X 9 HES 130 BT.

July 24, 1914: At this cor., I set off 19°56' N. on the decl. arc, and at 12<sup>h</sup> 06<sup>m</sup>, l.m.t., observe the sun on the meridian; the resulting lat. is 43°42' N.

---

Thence I run

S. 16°00' W., on a true line, along E. side of road exemption.
