- 5.00 Leave timber and enter cultivated land, bears NE. and SW.
- 10.00 Harvey Creek, 50 lks. wide, course SW.
- 13.50 Same creek, 50 lks. wide, course easterly.
- 14.97 To Cor. No. 14. In place of temporary stake,
 Set a sandstone, 24 x 12 x 8 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over a
 stone marked with a cross for Cor. No. 14 of this survey, marked
 14 HES 130 on side facing the claim; from which
- A maple, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 82°50' W., 210 lks. dist.,
 marked X 14 HES 130 BT.
- No other trees available for bearing trees; therefore raise a
 mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist. within
 the claim.

- 19.50 Harvey Creek, 50 lks. wide, course S.
- 24.60 Same creek, 50 lks. wide, course E.
- 26.50 Same creek, 50 lks. wide, course southerly.
- 35.50 Fence, bears NE. and SW.
- 35.60 Dry wash, 5 lks. wide, course NE.
- 41.50 Fence, bears E. and W.
- 42.25 Harvey Creek, 50 lks. wide, course NE.
- 44.00 To Cor. No. 15. In place of temporary stake,
 Set a sandstone, 24 x 14 x 5 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over a
 stone marked with a cross for Cor. No. 15 of this survey, marked
 15 HES 130 on side facing the claim; from which
- An alder, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 8°40' E., 162 lks. dist.,
 marked X 15 HES 130 BT.
- A maple, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 35°30' W., 197 lks. dist.,
 marked X 15 HES 130 BT.
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- Thence I run
- N. 16°00' E., on a true line, along W. side of road exemption.
