	<p>S. 15°00' W., on a random line, and at 31.72 chs., fall 11 lks. S. 75°00' E. of Cor. No. 12 of listing survey.</p> <p>(The true course of this line is S. 15°12' W., 31.72 chs.)</p> <p>Returning to Cor. No. 17 of this survey, above described, I run S. 15°12' W., on a true line.</p> <p>Ascend over mountainous land, through heavy fir, cedar, maple and alder timber and dense undergrowth.</p>
1.50	<p>Spur, slopes E., 30 ft. above Cor. No. 17; gradual descent along SE. slope.</p>
20.50	<p>Dry ravine, course SE.</p>
31.72	<p>To Cor. No. 18, identical with Cor. No. 12 of listing survey, which I destroy, and in its place,</p> <p>Set a sandstone, 24 x 12 x 10 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over a stone marked with a cross for Cor. No. 18 of this survey, marked 18 HES 130 on side facing the claim; from which</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 16°30' W., 39 lks. dist., marked X 18 HES 130 BT.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 74°45' W., 20 lks. dist., marked X 18 HES 130 BT.</p> <p>July 28, 1914: At this cor., I set off 19°04' N. on the decl. arc, and at 12<sup>h</sup> 06<sup>m</sup>, l.m.t., observe the sun on the meridian; the resulting lat. is 43°42' N.</p> <hr/> <p>Thence I sight to Cor. No. 11 of listing survey, and run S. 82°22' W., on a true line. (Listing surveyor evidently incor- rectly reported this bearing.)</p> <p>Over mountainous land, through fir, cedar, alder and maple timber and dense undergrowth.</p>
4.98	<p>To Cor. No. 19, identical with Cor. No. 11 of listing survey, which I destroy, and in its place</p> <p>Set a sandstone, 24 x 12 x 9 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over a stone marked with a cross for Cor. No. 19 of this survey, marked 19 HES 130 on side facing the claim; from which</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 13°15' E., 67 lks. dist., marked X 19 HES 130 BT.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 41°35' E., 83 lks. dist., marked X 19 HES 130 BT.</p> <hr/> <p>Thence I sight to Cor. No. 10 of listing survey, and run South, on a true line.</p> <p>Descend through fir, cedar, maple and alder timber and dense under- growth.</p>
1.13	<p>Bear Creek, 20 lks. wide, course E., 20 ft. below Cor. No. 19; ascend.</p>
2.41	<p>To Cor. No. 20 (30 ft. above creek), identical with cor. No. 10 of listing survey, which I destroy, and in its place,</p> <p>Set a sandstone, 24 x 10 x 10 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over a</p>
