To Cor. No. 22 on spur, slopes E. (60 ft. above creek bottom), identical with Cor. No. 4 of listing survey, which I destroy and in its place,

Set a sandstone, 24 x 12 x 10 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over a stone marked with a cross for Cor. No. 22 of this survey, marked 22 HES 130 on side facing the claim; from which

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 35°45' E., 18 lks. dist., marked X 22 HES 130 BT.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 73°45' W., 24 lks. dist., marked X 22 HES 130 BT.

Thence I run

S. 17°00' W., on a random line, and at 10.56 chs. intersect Cor. No. 3 of listing survey.

Returning to Cor. No. 22 of this survey, above described, I run

S. 17°00' W., on a true line, passing to List No. 6-632.

Gradual descent over mountainous land, through scattering fir, cedar, maple and alder timber and dense undergrowth.

10.56 To Cor. No. 23 (25 ft. below Cor. No. 22), identical with Cor. No. 3 of listing survey, which I destroy, and in its place,

Set a sandstone, 24 x 12 x 8 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over a stone marked with a cross for Cor. No. 23 of this survey, marked 23 HES 130 on side facing the claim; from which

A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears N. 82°00' E., 59 lks. dist., marked X 23 HES 130 BT.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 17°15' W., 52½ lks. dist., marked X 23 HES 130 BT.

Thence I sight to Cor. No. 2 of listing survey, and run

S. 84°39' W., on a true line.

Descend over mountainous land, through scattering fir, cedar, alder and maple timber and dense undergrowth.

5.92 To Cor. No. 24 (30 ft. below Cor. No. 23), identical with Cor. No. 2 of listing survey, which I destroy, and in its place,

Set a sandstone, 28 x 16 x 6 ins., 18 ins. in the ground, over a stone marked with a cross for Cor. No. 24 of this survey, marked 24 HES 130 on side facing the claim; from which

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 72°00' E., 197 lks. dist., marked X 24 HES 130 BT.

A maple, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 55°45' W., 208 lks. dist., marked X 24 HES 130 BT.

Thence I sight the temporary stake set on the N. bdy. of sec. 6, T. 22 S., R. 10 W. for Cor. No. 25 of this survey, and run

S. 45°30' W., on a true line.

Over mountainous land, through scattering fir, spruce, cedar, alder and maple timber.
