 .50 Leave mountainous land and enter level land, bears NE. and SW.
 2.04 Cor. No. 1 of listing survey, which I destroy. Pass to unlisted land.
 2.18 Fence, bears E. and W.; enter heavy timber, bears E. and W.
 3.70 To Cor. No. 25.
 Intersect the N. bdy. of sec. 6, T. 22 S., R. 10 W., S. 88°32' W., 17.58 chs. dist. from the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. on N. bdy. of sec. 6, and N. 88°32' E., 20.92 chs. dist. from the cor. of T. 22 S., Rs. 10 and 11 W.
 At point of intersection, in place of temporary stake,
 Set a sandstone, 30 x 12 x 8 ins., 20 ins. in the ground, over a stone marked with a cross for closing cor. and Cor. No. 25 of this survey, marked CC on NE. face, and 25 HES 130 on side facing the claim; from which
 A spruce, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 21°45' E., 118 lks. dist., marked X 25 HES 130 BT.
 A maple, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 39°00' E., 43 lks. dist., marked X 25 HES 130 BT.
