GENERAL DESCRIPTION

This claim lies on level bottom land, and is drained by Harvey Creek, which flows in a southerly direction through the claim and empties into the Umpqua River, about half a mile in a southerly direction from the south boundary of the claim.

Tidewater comes up the creek to the south boundary of the claim. About 25 acres of the land within the claim are under cultivation; the balance is covered with scattering fir and cedar and some heavy alder and maple timber, and a dense undergrowth of vine maple, willows, et cetera.

The soil is a sandy loam, except the mountainous soil, which is second rate.

The land is non-mineral in character.

The nearest post office is Gardiner, Oregon, about 12 miles in a westerly direction. The principal mode of travel is by boat on the Umpqua River.

LOCATION

This homestead is located in unsurveyed Sec. 31, T. 21 S., R. 10 W., and partly surveyed sec. 36, T. 21 S., R. 11 W., W. M., Oregon.

REPORT

The additional listing to H. E. S. No. 130, consisting of 11.20 A. was caused by simplifying the boundary lines of the claim, and in adjusting the south boundary of the claim to the south boundary of sec. 31, T. 21 S., R. 10 W.
