No. 143, mkd. W C on N. face, 4 H E S 143 on SE. face, with a cross (+) on top; from which

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.85°45'W., 16 lks. dist.,

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.66°00'W., 17½ lks. dist.,

both trees blazed and scribed W C 4 H E S 143 B T.

Soil, a dark loam, 1st rate.

Thence

N.78°35'E., on true line to Cor. 5.

Along rolling foot of mountain, through heavy timber.

(Measurement from true point for Cor. 4.)

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.59°15'W., 22 lks. dist.,

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.65°00'W., 46 lks. dist.,

both trees blazed and scribed W C 4 H E S 143 B T.

To Cor. No. 5, identical with Cor. H/11 of listing survey, 6-97, a post mkd. and witnessed as described by the listing surveyor, in place of which I set a porphyry stone, 24x10x7 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, for Cor. No. 5, mkd. 5 H E S 143 on SE. face, with a cross (+) on top; from which

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.27°15'E., 99 lks. dist.,

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.14°07'W., 80 lks. dist.,

both trees blazed and scribed 5 H E S 143 B T.

Soil a dark loam, 1st rate.

Thence

N.47°24'E., on true line to Cor. 6.

Along rolling foot of mountain, through heavy timber.

To Cor. No. 6, identical with Cor. H/12 of listing survey No. 6-97, a fir tree, 36 ins. diam., mkd. and witnessed as described by the listing surveyor. I mark tree 6 H E S 143 on SE. face, with a blaze on NE. and SW. faces of the tree; from which

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.70°45'W., 35 lks. dist.,

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.32°45'W., 14 lks. dist.,

both trees blazed and scribed 6 H E S 143 B T.
