Thence

N.28°30'E., on true line to Cor. 7.

Along rolling foot of mountain, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth. (Measurement from center of tree.)

SW cor. of fence.

Thence along fence line.

Leave heavy timber and dense undergrowth, bears NW and SE.

Lot fence, bears NW and SE.

10.43

To Cor. No. 7, identical with Cor. H/13 of listing survey No. 6-97 and listing survey No. 6-415, a post, mkd. and witnessed as described by the listing surveyor; in place of which I set a porphyry stone, 24x10x6 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, for Cor. 7, mkd. 7 H E S 143 on East face with a cross (+) on top; from which

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.52°15'W., 92 lks. dist.,

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.85°00'W., 76 lks. dist.,

both trees blazed and scribed 7 H E S 143 B T.

Soil a dark loam, 1st rate.

From this cor., Cor. H/14 of listing survey No. 6-97, identical with Cor. H/4 of listing survey No. 6-415, bears N.68°00'E., 3.50 chs. dist.

From last named cor., Cor. H/15 of listing survey No. 6-97, identical with Cor. H/3 of List No. 6-415 bears N.8°00'E., 4:35 chs. dist.; from last named cor., H/2 of list No. 6-415 bears N.5°00'W., 2.00 chs. dist. All mkd. and witnessed as described by the listing surveyor. I destroy and obliterate all evidence of said corners.

Thence

North on true line to Cor. No. 8.

Over rolling land, along claimant's fence.

Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course East.

7.70

To Cor. No. 8, identical with Cor. H/1 of listing survey No. 6-415, a fir tree, 40 ins. diam., mkd. and witnessed as described by the listing surveyor. I mark the tree 8 H E S 143 on SE. face, with a blaze on the S and E faces of the tree for Cor. 8; from which

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears West, 41 lks. dist.,

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.29°00'W., 55 lks. dist.,

both trees blazed and scribed 8 H E S 143 B T.

Soil a thin loam, with a clay subsoil, 2nd rate.

Thence

East on true line, to Cor. 9.
