CHAINS

A hemlock, 8 ins. diam., bears S.39°30'W., 26 lks. dist.,

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.41°30'W., 20 lks. dist.,

both trees blazed and scribed 17 H E S 143 B T.

Soil a dark loam, 1st rate.

June 22, 1914: Near cor. No. 16 of this survey, I set off 23°27'N. on the decl. arc, and at apparent noon, I obs. the sun on the mer., the resulting lat. is 43°05'N.

Thence

N.7°25'E., on true line to Cor. 18.

Over rolling land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

4.00 Trail (Forest Service), bears N. and S.

5.45 Creek, 8 lks. wide, course SE.

6.10 To Cor. No. 18, identical with Cor. H/3, a hemlock tree, 20 ins. diam., mkd. and witnessed as described by the listing surveyor, I mark tree 18 H E S 143 on SE. face, with a blaze on the NE. and SW. faces, for Cor. 18; from which

A hemlock, 20 ins. dia., bears N.74°00'W., 16 lks. dist.,

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.5°30'W., 50½ lks. dist.,

both trees blazed and scribed 18 H E S 143 B T.

Soil a dark loam, 1st rate.

Thence

N.19°12'E., on true line to Cor. 19.

Over rolling land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

.36 Trail (Forest Service), bears NE. and SW.

2.54 To Cor. No. 19, identical with Cor. H/4 of listing survey No. 6-590, Tract 3, a post, mkd. and witnessed as described by the listing surveyor, in place of which I set a conglomerate stone, 24x12x6 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, for Cor. 19, mkd. 19 H E S 143 on SE. face, with a cross (+) on top; from which

A fir, 8 ins. dia., bears S.43°00'W., 36 lks. dist.,

A fir, 18 ins. dia., bears N.46°25'W., 19 lks. dist.,

both trees blazed and scribed 19 H E S 143 B T.

Soil a dark loam, 1st rate.

Thence

S.70°07'E., on true line to Cor. 20.

Over level land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

.33 Trail (Forest Service), bears NE. and SW.
