June 24, 1914.

Thence

S.23°48'W., on true line to Cor. 22.

Along West side of road right of way, parallel to and 22.8 lks. right angle dist. from line 6 - 7 of listing survey No. 6-590, Tract 3.

Over rolling land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth, along foot of mountain.

9.00 Leave rolling and enter level land, bears N. and S.

12.89 To Cor. No. 22.

Set a porphyry stone, 24x16x8 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, for Cor. 22, mkd. 22 H E S 143 on SW. face, with a cross (+) on top; from which

A hemlock, 14 ins. diam., bears S.20°25'W., 53½ lks. dist.,

A hemlock, 18 ins. diam., bears N.43°10'W., 14 lks. dist.,

both blazed and scribed 22 H E S 143 B T.

Soil a dark loam, 1st rate.

Thence

S.66°12'E., on true line to Cor. 23.

Over level land, heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

.23 To Cor. No. 23, identical with Cor. H/7 of listing survey No. 6-590, Tract 3, a post mkd. and witnessed as described by the listing surveyor, in place of which I set a porphyry stone, 24x12x6 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, for Cor. 23, mkd. 23 H E S 143 on SW. face, with a cross (+) on top; from which

A hemlock, 8 ins. dia., bears S.89°00'E., 43½ lks. dist.,

A fir, 6 ins. dia., bears S.63°15'E., 24 lks. dist.,

both trees blazed and scribed 23 H E S 143 B T.

Soil a dark loam, 1st rate.

Thence - S.12°51'W., on true line to Cor. 24.

Over level land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

5.51 To Cor. No. 24, identical with Cor. H/19 of listing survey No. 6-97, a post mkd. and witnessed as described by the listing surveyor, in place of which I set a porphyry stone, 24x10x8 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, for Cor. No. 24, mkd. 24 H E S 143 on NW. face, with a cross (++) on top; from which

A hemlock, 24 ins. diam., bears N.69°00'E., 19 lks. dist.,

A hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears S.32°30'E., 29 lks. dist.,

both blazed and scribed 24 H E S 143 B T.

Soil a dark loam, 1st rate.
