CHAINS

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 46° 0' E., 62 lks. dist.,  
 A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 16° 0' W., 48 lks. dist.,  
 both blazed and scribed 3 H E S 144 B T.

Land, rolling.  
 Soil, a dark loam, 1st rate.

Thence

N. 71° 47' E., on true line to Cor. No. 4.

Over rolling land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

.20 Telephone line and trail (Forest Service), brs. NE. & SW.

1.70 Telephone lines and trail (Forest Service), brs. NW. & SE.

2.36 Telephone lines and trail (Forest Service), brs. NE. & SW.

4.83 To Cor. No. 4, identical with Cor. H/5 of listing survey, a post, mkd. and witnessed as described by Vernon V. Harpham, Assistant Forest Ranger, in place of which I set a porphyry stone, 24 x 10 x 8 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, for Cor. No. 4, mkd. 4 H E S 144 on SE. face, with a cross on top; from which

A fir, 20 ins. diam., brs. N. 62° 50' W., 46 lks. dist.,

A fir, 24 ins. diam., brs. N. 8° 25' W., 47 lks. dist.,

both blazed and scribed 4 H E S 144 B T.

Land, rolling.  
 Soil, a dark loam, 1st rate.

June 26, 1914; at Cor. No. 4 of this survey, I set off 23° 23' N. on the decl. arc, and at apparent noon, I obs. the sun on the mer.; the resulting lat. is 43° 3½' N.

Note: I consider the lines from Cor. H/5 to Cor. H/31 of listing survey are unduly crooked, made by unnecessary exclusions, and simplify bdry. as follows: From Cor. No. 4 of this survey, which is identical with Cor. H/5 of listing survey, I run to Cor. H/31 of listing survey, thereby eliminating Cors. H/6, H/7, H/8 and H/9 of listing survey, all of which are mkd. and witnessed as described by Vernon V. Harpham, Assistant Forest Ranger. I destroy these cors.

Thence

N. 8° 23' E., on true line to Cor. No. 5.

Over rolling land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

4.50 Telephone line and trail (Forest Service) brs. northeasterly and southwesterly.

36.00 Leave rolling and enter level land, brs. NW. and SE.

36.90 To Cor. No. 5, identical with Cor. H/31 of listing survey No. 6-350 and Cor. No. 30 of H.E.S. No. 143, established by me, a porphyry stone, 24 x 16 x 12 ins., set 14 ins. in the ground, mkd. 30 H E S 143 on N. face, with cross (+) on top. I mark the stone 5 H E S 144 on SE. face for Cor. No. 5 of this survey; from which

A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S. 7° 45' E., 18 lks. dist.,
