CHAINS

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N. 81° 0' W., 48 lks. dist.,
 both blazed and scribed 30 H E S 143 B T and 5 H E S 144 B T.

Land, rolling.
 Soil a dark loam, 1st rate.

Thence

N. 86° 8' E. on true line to Cor. No. 6.

Along line 30 and 29 of H.E.S. No. 143.

Over level land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- .14 Trail (Forest Service), brs. N. and S.
- .35 Telephone line (Forest Service), brs. N. & S.
- 2.29 Leave timber and undergrowth, brs. NW. & SE. Enter clearing, brs. NW. & SE.
- 4.79 Leave clearing and enter scattering timber and dense undergrowth, brs. NE. & SW.
- 6.34 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course SE.
- 11.51 Part of Rock Creek, 5 lks. wide, course S.
- 12.32 Rock Creek, 15 lks. wide, course S.
 Leave scattering and enter heavy timber, brs. N. & S.
- 12.79 To Cor. No. 6, identical with Cor. H/24 of listing survey, No. 6-350 and Cor. No. 29 of H.E.S. No. 143, established by me, a fir tree, 36 ins. diam., mkd. 29 H E S 143 on N. face, with a blaze on NE. and W. faces. I mark the tree 6 H E S 144 on SW. face, with a blaze on SW. face; from which
 - A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 85° 0' E., 32 lks. dist.,
 - A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 29° 35' E., 41 lks. dist.,
 both blazed and scribed 29 H E S 143 B T and 6 H E S 144 B T.
 Land, level.
 Soil a dark loam, 1st rate.

Thence

S. 30° 43' W., on true line to Cor. No. 7.

Over level land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 9.71 To Cor. No. 7, identical with Cor. H/25 of listing survey, a fir tree, 15 ins. diam., mkd. and witnessed as described by Vernon V. Harpham, Assistant Forest Ranger. I mark the tree 7 H E S 144 on W. face, with a blaze on the NE. and S. faces, for Cor. No. 7; from which
 - A fir, 26 ins. diam., brs. N. 73° 30' E., 21 lks. dist.,
 - A fir, 8 ins. diam., brs. S. 3° 45' E., 26 lks. dist.,
 both trees blazed and scribed 7 H E S 144 B T.
 Land, level.
 Soil a dark loam, 1st rate.
