S. 1° 36' E., on true line to Cor. No. 8.

Over level land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

To Cor. No. 8, identical with Cor. H/26 of listing survey, a post, mkd. and witnessed as described by Vernon V. Harpham, Assistant Forest Ranger, in place of which I set a porphyry stone, 24 x 12 x 10 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, for Cor. No. 8, mkd. 8 H E S 144 on West face, with a cross (+) on top; from which

A fir, 10 ins. diam., brs. N. 28° 0' E., 52 lks. dist.,

A fir, 16 ins. diam., brs. S. 36° 0' E., 11 lks. dist.,

both blazed and scribed 8 H E S 144 B T.

Land, level.

Soil, a dark loam, 1st rate.

Thence

S. 22° 6' W., on true line to Cor. No. 9.

Over level land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

To Cor. No. 9, identical with Cor. H/27 of listing survey, a fir tree, 30 ins. diam., mkd. and witnessed as described by Vernon V. Harpham, Assistant Forest Ranger. I mark the tree 9 H E S 144 on NW. face, with a blaze on the NE and SW faces for Cor. No. 9; from which

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 47° 30' E., 55 lks. dist.,

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 56° 30' E., 26 lks. dist.,

both blazed and scribed 9 H E S 144 B T.

Land, level.

Soil a dark loam, 1st rate.

Thence

S. 7° 9' W., on true line to Cor. No. 10.

Over level land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

Leave level and enter rolling land, brs. NE & SW.

To Cor. No. 10, identical with Cor. H/28 of listing survey, a small tree, mkd. and witnessed as described by Vernon V. Harpham Assistant Forest Ranger; in place of tree, which I remove, I set a porphyry stone, 24 x 10 x 8 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, for Cor. No. 10, mkd. 10 H E S 144 on NW. face, with a cross (+) on top; from which

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 26° 40' E., 32 lks. dist.,

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S. 36° 30' E., 7 lks. dist.,

both trees blazed and scribed 10 H E S 144 B T.

Land, level and rolling.

Soil a dark loam, 1st rate.
