Set a lava stone, 24x10x8 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over a stone marked with a cross, for cor. No. 4 of this survey, marked 4 HES 179 on side facing the claim; from which

A cedar, 42 ins. dia., bears N.45°30'W., 18 lks. dist., mkd.  
X 4 HES 179 B T.

A hemlock, 7 ins. dia., bears S.41°20'W., 39 lks. dist., mkd.  
X 4 HES 179 B T.

Raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist.  
within the claim.

Cor. No. 4 of listing survey bears N.65°55'E., 2.21 chs. dist.

Thence I run

within the claim.
