## CHAINS

Set a lava stone, 24x12x6 ins., 14 ins. in ground, over a stone marked with a cross for cor. No. 12 of this survey, marked 12 HES 179 on side facing the claim; from which

A fir, 12 ins. dia., bears N.45°30'E., 19 lks. dist., marked X 12 HES 179 B T.

A fir, 14 ins. dia., bears S.63°15'W., 12 lks. dist., marked X 12 HES 179 B T.

Raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist., within the claim.

Cor. No. 4 of Tract A bears S.65°55'W., 1.37 chs. dist.

September 4, 1916

September 5, 1916. From cor. No. 12 of this survey, above described, I run

N.65°55'E., on a true line (objective cor. in sight).

Along level land, through fir, maple, and cedar timber and undergrowth.

Cor. No. 13, identical with Cor. No. 4 of listing survey, which I destroy, and in its place

Set a sandstone, 26x12x8 ins., 16 ins. in the ground, over a stone marked with a cross for cor. No. 13 of this survey, marked 13 HES 179 on side facing the claim; from which

A fir, 10 ins. dia., bears N.74°15'E., 39 lks. dist., marked X 13 HES 179 B T.

A maple, 12 ins. dia., bears S.69°30'W., 69 lks. dist., marked X 13 HES 179 B T.

Raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist. within the claim.

Thence I run

N.25°00'E., on a random line, and at 14.09 chs. fall 21.5 lks. N.65°00'W. of cor. No. 5 of listing survey.

(The true bearing and length of this line is N.25°52'E., 14.09 chs.)

Returning to cor. No. 13 of this survey, above described, I run

N.25°52'E., on a true line.

Over level land, through fir and maple timber and undergrowth.

Trail, bears northeast and southwest.

Cor. No. 14, identical with cor. No. 5 of listing survey, which I destroy and in its place

Set a granite stone, 28x8x8 ins., 18 ins. in the ground, over a stone marked with a cross for cor. No. 14 of this survey, marked 14 HES 179 on side facing the claim; from which

A yew, 8 ins. dia., bears N.17°45'E., 31 lks. dist., marked X 14 HES 179 B T.

A fir, 14 ins. dia., bears S.1°30'W., 22 lks. dist., marked X 14 HES 179 B T.
