2.00 Left bank of South Umpqua River, course south.

3.70 Right bank of river.

9.41 Cor. No. 19, identical with cor. No. 10 of listing survey, on right bank of South Umpqua River, which is an alder tree, 24 ins. dia. I destroy listing survey marks and mark 19 HES 179 on side facing the claim and M C on side facing river for meander cor. and cor. No. 19 of this survey; from which

A fir, 10 ins. dia., bears N.77°00'E., 16 lks. dist., mkd.
 X 19 HES 179 M C B T.

A fir, 12 ins. dia., bears N.16°30'W., 17 lks. dist., mkd.
 X 19 HES 179 M C B T.

Pits and mound impracticable.

Thence I run with meanders of right bank of South Umpqua River, downstream.

Through dense undergrowth.

S.75°00'W., 4.00 chs.

S.49°45'W., 5.00 chs.

S.26°30'W., 16.00 chs.

S.53°03'W., 5.01 chs. to

Cor. No. 20, identical with cor. No. 1 of listing survey, which I destroy, and in its place

Set a granite stone, 26x8x8 ins., 16 ins. in the ground, over a stone marked with a cross for meander cor. and cor. No. 20 of this survey, marked M C on side facing river and 20 HES 179 on side facing the claim; from which

An alder, 14 ins. dia., bears S.19°30'W., 66 lks. dist., marked
 X 20 HES 179 M C B T.

No other bearings available. Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, on line, 3½ ft. distant northwest of cor.

Thence I run

N.49°01'W., on a true line (objective cor. in sight).

Over level land, through undergrowth.

0.44 Nicholas Creek, 2 lks. wide, course southeast.

0.82 To cor. No. 8, the place of beginning.
