CHAINS

Set a sandstone, 16x10x8 ins., 11 ins. in the ground, mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face; from which

A hemlock, 14 ins. dia., bears N.3°00'E., 168 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 10 B T (new)

No other bearing tree available, raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., W. of cor.

Thence I run

S.89°54'E. (mean of N. and S. boundaries of W. half of sec. 10), on a true line, through center of sec. 10.

40.15 Intersect longitudinal $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. line S.0°06'W., 49.40 chs. dist. from the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 3 and 10 and N.0°06'E., 39.70 chs. dist. from the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 10 and 15.

Set a temporary stake for center of sec. 10.

Thence I run

N.0°06'E., along the longitudinal $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. line.

20.20 (Proportional measurement) Set a temporary stake for 1/16 sec. cor. and cor. No. 6 of this survey.

H. E. S. No. 190

September 23, 1916: I begin at cor. No. 1 of the Homestead Entry Survey, identical with the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 3 and 10, which is a sandstone, heretofore described. I mark the stone with a cross on top for chaining point and alongside of cor.

Set a Forest Service iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. dia., with brass cap, 24 ins. in the ground, mkd. 1 HES 190.

Thence I run

S.89°34'E., on a true line along sec. line bet. secs. 3 and 10.

Along southerly slope, through fir and alder timber and undergrowth, gradual descent.

24.85 Five Mile Creek, 10 lks. wide, course SW., 60 ft. below cor. No. 1.

25.21 Wagon road, bears NE. and SW.

25.50 Ascend NW. slope.

33.20 Top, 250 ft. above creek; descend 40 ft. into

33.40 Draw, course NW. Asc. NW. slope.

40.30 Cor. No. 2 (150 ft. above draw) identical with cor. secs. 2, 3, 10, and 11, which is a granite stone, heretofore described. I mark the stone with a cross on top, for chaining point, and alongside of cor.

Set a cedar post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross, mkd. 2 HES 190 on side facing the claim.

No stone available for cor.

September 23, 1916: At the above mentioned cor., I set off 0°09'S. on the decl. arc; and at 11h52m l.m.t., obs. the sun on the mer.; the resulting lat. is 43°51'N.
