IMPROVEMENTS

All the buildings and most of the improvements of whatever kind are located in that portion of H. E. No. 02958 lying within the surveyed W. half of sec. 10.

There are approximately 3 acres of land under cultivation on this claim.

Value \$150.00

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

This claim lies in a narrow valley along Five Mile Creek. The bottom land along the creek is deep and exceptionally fertile and adapted to the growing of hay, grain, and fruits. The greater part of the remainder is rather steep, but probably has grazing possibilities. About three-fourths of the eastern portion consists of a ridge of an elevation of about 500 ft. above Five Mile Creek, altogether too steep for cultivation.

Sufficient water for all purposes is available.

The character of the land is non-mineral.

The nearest post office is Ada, Oregon, about 5 miles by wagon road NW. of claim. This is also the nearest railroad station and is on the Willamette Pacific Railroad.

LOCATION

This homestead is located in the E. half of sec. 10, unsurveyed, T. 20 S., R. 11 W., W.M.

It adjoins the portion of same entry No. 02958, lying within the W. half of sec. 10, surveyed.

REPORT

The survey of this homestead embraces an area wholly confined within the listed and entered description.

The bearings obtained by the solar were checked by the angles of the survey independently read on the horizontal limb.

No officer qualified to administer oaths was available; therefore the final affidavit of assistants was made before the surveyor in his official capacity.
