20.40	<p>Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course northwest.</p>
30.05	<p>Cor. No. 2, 60 ft. below cor. No. 1, identical with cor. No. 2 of listing survey, which I destroy and in its place</p>
	<p>Set a lava stone, 24x14x10 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross for cor. No. 2 of this survey, mkd. 2 HES 192 on side facing the claim; from which</p>
	<p>A fir, 30 ins. dia., bears N.49°27'E., 17 lks. dist., mkd. X 2 HES 192 B T.</p>
	<p>A cedar, 9 ins. dia., bears N.38°32'W., 11 lks. dist., mkd. X 2 HES 192 B T.</p>
	<p>Raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist. within the claim.</p>
	<p>Thence I run</p>
	<p>S.52°39'E. on a true line (objective cor. in sight).</p>
	<p>Gradual ascent through scattering fir, pine, cedar timber and undergrowth.</p>
13.10	<p>Cor. No. 3, 50 ft. above cor. No. 2, identical with cor. No. 3 of listing survey, which I destroy and in its place</p>
	<p>Set a basalt stone, 29x10x10 ins., 19 ins. in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross for cor. No. 3 of this survey, mkd. 3 HES 192 on side facing the claim; from which</p>
	<p>A fir, 24 ins. dia., bears N.71°10'E., 50 lks. dist., mkd. X 3 HES 192 B T.</p>
	<p>A pine, 60 ins. dia., bears S.6°00'W., 32 lks. dist., mkd. X 3 HES 192 B T.</p>
	<p>Raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist. within the claim.</p>
	<p>Thence I run</p>
	<p>S.35°00'W., on a random line, and at 21.33 chs. fall 27 lks. S.55°00'E. of cor. No. 4 of listing survey.</p>
	<p>(The true bearing and length of this line is S.35°43'W., 21.33 chs.)</p>
	<p>Returning to cor. No. 3 of this survey, above described, I run</p>
	<p>S.35°43'W. on a true line.</p>
	<p>Over gently rolling land, through undergrowth, fir and pine timber.</p>
21.33	<p>Cor. No. 4, identical with cor. No. 4 of listing survey, which I destroy, and in its place</p>
	<p>Set a lava stone, 24x14x8 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross for cor. No. 4 of this survey, mkd. 4 HES 192 on side facing the claim; from which</p>
	<p>A pine, 10 ins. dia., bears N.40°45'E., 50 lks. dist., mkd. X 4 HES 192 B T.</p>
	<p>A fir, 42 ins. dia., bears S.25°00'E., 8 lks. dist., mkd. X 4 HES 192 B T.</p>
