CHAINS

Raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dist. within the claim.

Latitude observation taken at this cor. is described on page 2.

Thence I run

S.65°00'W., on a random line, and at 32.36 chs. fall 17 lks. S.25°00'E. of cor. No. 5 of listing survey.

(The true bearing and length of this line is S.65°18'W., 32.36 chs.)

Returning to cor. No. 4 of this survey, above described, I run

S.65°18'W., on a true line.

Descend westerly slope, through fir and pine timber and undergrowth.

6.40 Land, level, 110 ft. below cor. No. 4.

12.15 Leave level land; descend westerly slope.

27.10 Foot of descent, 330 ft. below cor. No. 4; thence over level land, through dense undergrowth.

32.36 Cor. No. 5, identical with cor. No. 5 of listing survey, which I destroy, and in its place

Set a cedar post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross for cor. No. 5 of this survey, mkd. 5 HES 192 on side facing the claim; from which

A fir, 24 ins. dia., bears S.57°30'W., 57 lks. dist., mkd. X 5 HES 192 B T.

A fir, 8 ins. dia., bears S.66°05'E., 31 lks. dist., mkd. X 5 HES 192 B T.

Raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dist. within the claim.

No suitable stone available for cor.

Thence I run

N.19°50'W., on a true line (objective cor. in sight).

Over fairly level land, through dense undergrowth, fir and cedar timber.

8.66 Cor. No. 6, identical with cor. No. 6 of listing survey, which I destroy and in its place

Set a lava stone, 24x10x8 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross for cor. No. 6 of this survey, mkd. 6 HES 192 on side facing the claim; from which

A fir, 16 ins. dia., bears S.12°45'W., 72 lks. dist., mkd. X 6 HES 192 B T.

A fir, 16 ins. dia., bears S.84°20'W., 22 lks. dist., mkd. X 6 HES 192 B T.

Raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dist. within the claim.

Thence I run
