CHAINS

N.23°00'E., on a random line, and at 19.02 chs. fall 5½ lks. S.67° 00'E. of cor. No. 1 of this survey.

(The true bearing and length of this line is N.22°50'E., 19.02 chs.)

Returning to corner No. 6 of this survey, above described, I run N.22°50'E., on a true line.

Ascend south slope, through fir, pine and cedar timber and undergrowth.

16.40 Top of ascent, 220 ft. above cor. No. 6, thence on level land.

16.42 Trail, bears east and west.

19.02 Cor. No. 1, the place of beginning.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

This claim lies on a flat on top of a ridge which slopes westerly to the South Umpqua River, about 3 miles dist., and about 1500 ft. above river.

The soil is a first rate clay loam, capable of producing a variety of garden truck, hay and grain.

Sufficient water for domestic use is obtained from a spring north of the house.

The character of the land is non-mineral.

The nearest post office is Tiller, Oregon, about 32½ miles dist. by trail and wagon road southwest of claim.

Riddle, Oregon, the nearest railroad station, is on the S. P. Railroad, about 56 miles by trail and wagon road southwesterly of claim.

This homestead is located in the northwest part of unsurveyed T. 29 S., R. 2 E., Willamette Meridian, Oregon.
