REPORT

The survey of this homestead embraces an area wholly confined within the listed and entered descriptions.

The disagreements bet. these field notes and the listed and entered descriptions regarding the bearings and distances are due to errors in the latter. The bearings obtained by the solar were checked by the angles of the survey independently read on the horizontal limb.

H.E.S. No. 179, surveyed by me, lies southwesterly about 3 miles dist.

No suitable location for U.S. Location Monument bet. these two claims is available; hence the necessity of establishing one for each claim.

No officer qualified to administer oaths was available. Therefore the final affidavit of assistants was made before the surveyor in his official capacity.
