## CHAINS

Thence I run

S.15°33'W., on a true line, along westerly bdy. of road exemption (Tract C), parallel to and 30 lks. dist. from line 5 - 6 of Tract A of this survey.

Over open level clearing.

8.80

Leave clearing; enter dense undergrowth on dry creek bed.

15.12

Pass from listed to unlisted land.

20.94

Cor. No. 8 and closing corner.

Intersect the line bet. secs. 1 and 12, T. 22 S., R. 11 W., N.89°42'W., 12.06 chs. dist. from the cor. of secs. 1 and 12, heretofore described and S.89°42'E., 28.27 chs. dist. from the  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. bet. secs. 1 and 12, heretofore described.

At point of intersection

Set a sandstone, 26x14x5 ins., 16 ins. in the ground, over a stone marked with a cross for closing corner and cor. No. 8 of this survey, marked 8 H E S 213 on side facing the claim and C C on north face; from which

A cedar, 12 ins. dia., bears N.43°15'W., 9 lks. dist., marked X 8 H E S 213 C C B T.

A cedar, 6 ins. dia., bears N.1°15'E., 7 lks. dist., marked X 8 H E S 213 C C B T.

Cor. is at base of steep easterly slope; pits and mound impracticable.

Cor. No. 5 of Tract A of this survey, bears S.89°42'E., 31 lks. dist.

No solar observation possible during day because of being in tall timber.

September 1, 1917

September 3, 1917: From cor. No. 8 of this survey, above described, I run

N.89°42'W., on a true line, along line bet. secs. 1 and 12.

Ascend steep east slope, through dense undergrowth and scattering timber.

Cor. No. 9 and closing corner, at intersection of prolongation of line 8 - 9 of listing survey with line bet. secs. 1 and 12 as determined by previous preliminary retracement.

Set a sandstone, 24x10x6 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over a stone marked with a cross for closing corner and cor. No. 9 of this survey, marked 9 H E S 213 on side facing the claim and C C on north face; from which

An alder, 16 ins. dia., bears N.76°15'W., 7 lks. dist., marked X 9 H E S 213 C C B T.

A cedar, 8 ins. dia., bears S.13°00'W., 33 lks. dist., marked X 9 H E S 213 C C B T.

Cor. is on steep sidehill; pits and mound impracticable.
