

HOMESTEAD ENTRY SURVEY NO 213
 SIUSLAW NATIONAL FOREST

CHAINS

A fir, 24 ins. dia., bears S.84°00'W., 24 lks. dist.,
 marked X 11 H E S 213 B T.

Cor. is on steep side hill; pits and mound impracticable.

Thence I run

N.27°00'E., on a random line, and at 3.03 chs. fall 33 lks. N.63°
 00'W. of cor. No. 2 of listing survey.

(The true bearing and length of this line is N.33°13'E., 3.05 chs.)

Returning to cor. No. 11 of this survey above described, I run

N.33°13'E., on a true line.

Descend east slope, through dense undergrowth and scattering timber.

Cor. No. 12, 15 ft. below cor. No. 11.

Intersect the south bdy. of Lot 6, fractional sec. 1, west 20.84
 chs. dist. from cor. No. 6 of this survey and east 13.45 chs. dist.
 from temporary stake set for southwest cor. of Lot 6.

At point of intersection

Set a sandstone, 28x10x4 ins., 18 ins. in ground, over a stone mark-
 ed with a cross for cor. No. 12 of this survey, marked 12 H E S
 213 on side facing the claim; from which

A cherry, 8 ins. dia., bears N.43°00'E., 14 lks. dist.,
 marked X 12 H E S 213 B T.

A maple, 12 ins. dia., bears S.10°15'W., 38 lks. dist.,
 marked X 12 H E S 213 B T.

Pits and mound impracticable, as corner is on steep east slope.

Cor. No. 2 of listing survey, which I destroy, bears N.33°13'E.,
 0.70 lks. dist.

Thence I run

East on a true line, along south bdy. of Lot 6, fractional sec. 1.

Over level land, through dense undergrowth and scattering timber.

To cor. No. 7, place of beginning of Tract B.

No solar observations possible during day because of being in tall
 timber.
