THEODORE LODE

- Beginning at Cor. No. 1.
- A fir post, 5 ft. long, 5 ins. sq., set 2 ft. in the ground, in mound of earth, scribed T 1-805; whence
- A laurel, 7 ins. diam., bears S. 76° E., 37.2 ft., and
- A fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 60°45' W., 8.5 ft., each blazed and scribed BT T 1-805.
- The NE. cor. of sec 32, T. 30 S., R. 4 W. of the W. M., bears N. 2°56' E., 509.0 ft.
- Thence N. 70°40' W.
- 583.00 To Cor. No. 2.
- A fir post, 4½ ft. long, 6 ins. sq., set 2 ft. in the ground, in mound of earth, scribed T 2-805; whence
- A laurel, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 29°50' E., 25.5 ft., and
- A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears N. 17°20' W., 7.0 ft., each blazed and scribed BT T 2-805.
- Thence S. 19°09' W.
- 420.00 Creek, 2 ft. wide, in deep canyon, flows NW.
- 858.00 To trail, course NW. and SE.
- 1470.00 To Cor. No. 3.
- A yew stake, 4½ ft. long, 6 ins. sq., set 2 ft. in the ground, in mound of earth, scribed T 3-805; whence
- A yew tree, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 37°10' E., 13.5 ft., and
- A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears N. 3°45' W., 17.6 ft., each blazed and scribed BT T 3-805.
- Thence S. 70°40' E.
- 598.20 To Cor. No. 4.
- A fir post, 5 ft. long, 5 ins. sq., set 2 ft. in the ground, in mound of earth, scribed T 4-805; whence
- A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 57°20' E., 21.0 ft., and
- A fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 76°18' W., 34.7 ft., each blazed and scribed BT T 4-805.
- Thence N. 18°33' E.
- 514.00 Top of ridge, course NW. and SE.
- 1215.00 Creek, 2 ft. wide, in deep ravine, flows N. 80° W.
- 1470.10 To Cor. No. 1, the place of beginning.
