I certify that the value of the labor and improvements made upon, or for the benefit of this claim by the claimant or his grantors is not less than five hundred dollars, and that said improvements consist of:

- No. 1 The discovery cut and tunnel, the mouth of the tunnel being the discovery point, is on the lode line 726 ft. from a point on line 3-4, S. 70°40' E., 300 ft. from Cor. No. 3, running S. 40° E., 55 ft. to the face. From the mouth of tunnel a cut, 4 ft. wide, 8 ft. face, runs N. 40° W., 14 ft., thence S. 60° W., 20 ft. to mouth.
Value of cut and tunnel, \$500.00.
- No. 2 A cut the face of which bears from Cor. No. 3, ~~Theodore~~ lode, N. 38°15' E., 799 ft., 3 ft. wide, 6 ft. face, running N. 60° W., 32 ft. to mouth.
Value, \$50.00.
- No. 3 A cut and tunnel, the mouth of cut bears N. 58°35' E., 338 ft. from Cor. No. 3, ~~Theodore~~ lode, 5 ft. wide, 7 ft. face, running S. 41° E., 16 ft. to mouth of tunnel, $4\frac{1}{2}$ x 6 ft., timbered, running S. 41° E., 23 ft. to face.

- No. 4 A cut, the mouth of which bears from Cor. No. 3, ~~Theodore~~ lode, N. 60°01' E., 239 ft., 9 ft. wide, 12 ft. face, running S. 40° E., 12 ft. to face.

- No. 5 A caved tunnel and cut. The mouth of the tunnel bears N. 63°58' E., 307 ft. from Cor. No. 3, ~~Theodore~~ lode, $4\frac{1}{2}$ x 6 ft., timbered, running N. 80° E., 12 ft. to cave. From mouth of tunnel, a cut, 5 ft. wide, 7 ft. face, runs S. 80° W., 12 ft. to mouth.

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Berger and Sons transit No. 5008. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined from a direct solar observation. The distances were measured with a 400 ft. steel tape.
