## REPORT

The lode line, end lines and side lines of this claim were run directly upon the ground, and the corners established as found in the location. Tie lines were run directly upon the ground.

The NE. cor. of sec. 32, T. 30 S., R. 4 W., of the W. M., is a porphyry stone, 4 x 6 ins., extending 6 ins. above ground, marked with 1 groove on the S. and 4 grooves on the E. edge. Near it are two bearing trees, blazed and scribed T 30 S R 4 W S 32 BT and T 30 S R 4 W S 29 BT.

The disagreement between the courses and distances of this survey and those of the location certificates are due to errors in the latter.

The oaths of assistants were administered by myself in order to avoid the expense of having them go a great distance to appear before a notary.
