

Dependent Resurvey of Portion of East Boundary, T. 29 S., R. 5 W.

CHAINS

- 1.48 Center line of dirt drive-way, bears N. 15° W. and S.
- 6.92 Woven-wire fence, bears E. and W.; enter logged area and scattering timber.
- 23.57 Spur, slopes SW.; desc. 20 ft. over NW. slope.
- 27.10 Head of ravine, course SW.; asc. 39 ft. over SW. slope.
- 29.46 Ridge and main divide between S/ Myrtle Creek and N. Myrtle Creek, bears N. 80° E. and S. 80° W.; desc. 386 ft. over N. slope.
- 39.30 Point for the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

from which

- A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 58½° E., 153½ lks. dist., marked T29S R4W S18 BT.
- A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears S. 11½° E., 39 lks. dist., marked T29S R4W S19 BT.
- A maple, 11 ins. diam., bears S. 63° W., 90 lks. dist., marked T29S R5W S24 BT.
- A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 3° W., 82 lks. dist., marked T29S R5W S13 BT.

From this point a locally established cor. bears North, 6 lks. dist., monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., 18 ins. above ground, established and recorded by J. H. Markham in 1954.

from which locally established BTs.

- A sawed fir stump, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 20½° E., 15½ lks. dist., marked with a partially healed blaze.
- A sawed fir stump, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 62° E., 32 lks. dist., marked with a partially healed blaze.
- A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 22½° W., 44 lks. dist., with a partially healed blaze.
- A turned-out fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 37° W., 24 lks. dist., with a partially healed blaze.

Land, agricultural in S. portion, high ridge in N. portion. Soil, granular clay and loam. Timber, fir, oak, madrone, maple, cedar, and pine; undergrowth, poison-oak, and small reproduction.

N. 0° 39' E., between secs. 13 and 18.

Descend 273 ft. over N. slope, through logged area and scattering timber.

- 10.26 Enter field, edge bears NE. and SW.
- 19.50 North Myrtle Creek, 25 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. 177 ft. over S. slope.
