67.50	Cedar Hollow Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N. 5° W.; asc. 71 ft. over E. slope.
69.20	Abandoned tractor road, bears N. 5° W. and S.
70.58	Spur, slopes N. 30° E.; asc. 5 ft. over NE. slope.
72.56	Small ravine, course N. 20° E.; asc. 191 ft. over NE. slope.
