


Survey of Portion of Subdivisional Lines of Sec. 25, T. 29 S., R. 5 W.

CHAINS	
23.09	Spur, slopes N.; desc. 34 ft. over NW. slope.
24.11	Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N.; asc. 92 ft. over NE. slope.
27.28	Spur, slopes N.; desc. 50 ft. over NW. slope.
29.92	Ravine, course NE.; asc. 231 ft. over E. slope changing to NE. slope.
35.51	Spur, slopes N. 20° E.; desc. 62 ft. over NW. slope.
39.05	Ravine, course N.; asc. 12 ft. over NE. slope.
39.72	Point of intersection with the N. and S. center line and the center $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 25. Ascend 99 ft. over NE. slope.
42.45	Spur, slopes N. 30° E.; desc. 162 ft. over NW. slope.
48.03	Head of ravine, course N.; asc. 231 ft. along N. slope changing to NE. slope.
56.55	Spur, slopes N.; desc. 63 ft. over NW. slope.
59.395	Point for the center W $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of secs. 25. Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked <div style="text-align: center;"> <p>W $\frac{1}{16}$</p>  <p>S 25 1957</p> <p>Cor. falls at foot of descent, slopes N.</p> </div> Ascend 28 ft. along N. slope.
65.16	Ridge, main divide between Cedar Hollow Creek and S. Myrtle Creek, bears S. 30° E. and NW.; desc. 116 ft. over SW. slope.
68.97	Head of ravine, course SW.; desc. 138 ft. along S. slope.
78.41	Spur, slopes SW.; desc. 16 ft. over SW. slope.
79.07	The $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 26.
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	From the center E $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of sec. 25. N. 0° 07' E., on the N. and S. center line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 25. Descend 37 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
2.04	Branch, $\frac{1}{2}$ lk. wide, course N. 80° W.; desc. 13 ft. over NW. slope.
3.24	Spring branch, course W.; asc. 74 ft. over SW. slope.
8.32	Top of ascent, slopes W.; desc. 9 ft. over NW. slope.
10.82	Foot of desc. slopes W.; asc. 72 ft. over S. slope.
14.65	Spur ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 242 ft. over steep N. slope of slide area.
19.56	Point for the NE $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of sec. 25, at intersection with E. and W. center line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 25.
