

Dependent Resurvey of Line bet. Secs. 7 and 18, T. 25 S., R. 1 W.
 Executed by Lynn M. Roseberry, Cadastral Surveyor
 Under Special Instructions dated June 21, 1957

CHAINS

(Restoring the 1900 survey by Johnson)

The cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18, monumented with a basalt stone, 16x12x10 ins., firmly set 11 ins. in the ground, marked with 5 grooves on E. and 4 grooves on S. face; from which the remaining original bearing trees:

A fir, 25 ins. diam., bears S. 30° E., 67½ lks. dist., with a healed blaze. (Record dist., 75 lks.)

A fir snag, 35 ins. diam., bears S. 39° W., 67½ lks. dist., with scribe marks S 8 visible on partly opened blaze. (Record S. 40° W., 72 lks. dist.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap marked

from which

A chinquapin, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 49° E., 31 lks. dist., marked T25S RLW S8 BT.

A fir, 35 ins. diam., bears S. 22½° W., 108½ lks. dist., marked T25S RLW S18 BT.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 67° W., 73 lks. dist., marked T25S RLW S7 BT.

Deposited the basalt stone alongside the base of the iron post.

S. 89° 25' W., bet. secs. 7 and 18, marking and blazing the true line.

Ascend 53 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and undergrowth.

2.68 Spur, slopes NE.; descend 200 ft. over NW. slope, changing to N. slope.

15.37 Foot of descent, slopes N.; ascend 111 ft. over NE. slope.

19.36 Point for the E. 1/16 cor. of secs. 7 and 18.

Set an iron post, 36 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A hemlock, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 25½° W., 31½ lks. dist., marked E 1/16 S7 BT.

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 46½° W., 16 lks. dist., marked E 1/16 S18 BT.

Ascend 142 ft. over NE. slope, along N. edge of logged area.

24.14 Spur, slopes NE.; descend 401 ft. over NW. slope changing to N. slope.

38.72 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 18, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
