

Dependent Resurvey of Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 29 S., R. 7 W.

CHAINS

Descend 20 ft. over broken NE. slope through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

1.00 Spur, slopes N. 15° E.; descend 710 ft. over NW. slope.

30.00 Branch, 5 lks. wide, course N. 60° E.; ascend 80 ft. over SE. slope.

31.00 Graded road, 20 lks. wide, bears NE. and SW.

34.00 Spur, slopes E.; descend 40 ft. over NE. slope.

35.80 Ravine, drains SE.; ascend 110 ft. over S. slope.

39.345 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 11 and 12, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N. 43° E., 40 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S12 BT.

A madrona, 40 ins. diam., bears S. 6° W., 67 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S11 BT.

Ascend 500 ft. over S. slope, changing to SE. slope.

66.05 Ridge, bears N. 80° E., and S. 80° W.; descend 335 ft. over N. slope, changing to broken NW. slope.

78.69 The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12, reestablished by the County Surveyor in 1923 and monumented with an iron pipe, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, from which bearing trees and a bearing object marked by the County Surveyor:

A rock ledge bears N. 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 429 lks. dist., mkd. S1 CS B0.

A white oak, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 80 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E., 342 lks. dist., plainly blazed and healed.

A white oak, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 22° W., 18 lks. dist., plainly blazed and healed.

A white oak, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 29° W., 398 lks. dist., plainly blazed and healed.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

Reset the iron pipe alongside the iron post.

Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Timber, fir, cedar, pine, oak, maple, madrona and alder. Undergrowth, vine maple, arrowwood, poison oak and fern.
