An oak, 18 ins., diam., bears N. 61° 20' W., 60 lks. dist.,
both trees blazed and scribed 6 HES 93 BT.

Land, mountainous. Timber, pine, fir and oak. Soil, very stony,

Thence, N. 10° 15' E. on true line to Cor. 7.

Over mountainous land, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth. Ascend.

23.50 To Cor. No. 7, 600 ft. above Cor. 6, identical with Cor. H/6 of listing survey, a basalt boulder, in place, 2 ft. N. and S., 2 ft. E. and W., 1 ft high, mkd. and witnessed as described by Asher Ireland, Assistant Forest Ranger. I mkd. the boulder 7 HES 93 on SE. face, with a cross (+) on top, from which

A pine, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 27° 45' E., 79 lks. dist.,

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 69° 00' W., 19 lks. dist.,
both trees blazed and scribed 7 HES 93 BT.

Land, mountainous. Timber, pine and fir. Soil, very stony, third rate.

Thence, S. 89° 52' E., on true line to Cor. 8.

Over mountainous land, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth. Ascend.

2.75 Top of mountain, bears N. and S., 15 ft. above Cor. 7.

17.23 To Cor. No. 8, 175 ft. below top of mountain, identical with Cor. H/7 of listing survey, a post, mkd. and witnessed as described by Asher Ireland, Assistant Forest Ranger; in place of which I set a basalt stone, 24x10x8 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, for Cor. 8, mkd. 8 HES 93 on SW. face, with a cross (+) on top, from which

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N. 19° 30' E., 49 lks. dist.,

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 35° 30' E., 138 lks. dist.,
both trees blazed and scribed 8 HES 93 BT.

Land, mountainous. Timber, pine and fir. Soil, very stony, 3rd rate.

Thence, S. 7° 00' W., on true line to Cor. 9.

Over mountainous land, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth. Descend.

3.64 Ravine, course SE., 75 ft. below Cor. 8 Ascend.

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 8° 30' E., 76 lks. dist.,

A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S. 48° 00' W., 29 lks. dist.,
both trees blazed and scribed 9 HES 93 BT.
