CHAINS

Metes and bounds survey of Perry J. Wright Homestead Entry, Umpqua National Forest, Oregon

July 10, 1914:- There being no other established monument within two miles, I establish U.S.L.M. No. 142, identical with the Forest Service Monument, which is mkd. and witnessed as described (in field notes of the H.E.S. No. 93) (and further described as follows:)

Lat. 43° 20' N., and approx. long. 122° 31' W.

The NW. cor. of the house at Illihee Ranger Station bears S. 8° 22' W., 4.68 chs. dist.

This monument is identical with the Forest Service Monument established for H.E.S. 142, and Illihee Ranger Station.

This monument is located on a rolling bench, sloping to the South, and the North Fork of the Umpqua River. The bench is about 500 ft. above the river.

H. E. S. No. 142.

July 10, 1914:- Beginning at Cor. No. 1, identical with Cor. H/1 of 1st survey, a fir, 30 ins. diam., mkd. and witnessed as described by G. A. Bonebrake, Forest Ranger, I blaze and scribe the tree 1 HES 142 on NW. face, for Cor. 1, from which

A cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 64° 00' W., 67 lks. dist.,

A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears N. 12° 00' W., 96 lks. dist.,
 both trees blazed and scribed 1 HES 142 BT.

U.S.L.M. No. 142, heretofore described, bears S. 5° 03' E., 5.23 chs. dist.

Pits and mounds impracticable at this and all other cors.

 1.13 Same trail, bears NW. and SE.
 3.57 Same trail, bears NE. and SW.
 6.45 Same trail, bears NW. and SE.
 7.00 Telephone line, bears N. and S.
 7.78 Trail, bears NE. and SW.
 7.82 SE. cor. of fence, around cultivated tract. Thence along fence.
 12.58 NE. cor. of fence around same tract.
 12.80 Trail bears NW. and SE.
 19.86 Claimant's fence, bears E. and W. Enter cultivated field, bears E. and W.
 26.20 Leave cultivated field, bears NW. and SE.
 26.25 Claimant's fence, bears NW. and SE. Leave rolling and enter mountainous land, bears NE. and SW. Ascend.
 47.34 To Cor. No. 2, 135 ft. above point of ascent, (or 235 ft. above Cor. 1), identical with Cor. H/2 of listing survey, a fir tree, 28 ins. diam., mkd. and witnessed as described by G. A. Bonebrake, Forest Ranger; I blaze and scribe the tree 2 HES 142 on SW. face, for
