

## County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Homestead Entry Survey No. 178, T. 26 S., R. 2 E.

CHAINS

Thence I run, S. 80° 35' E. on a true line (objective cor. in sight.)  
Along north bdy. of flat; through scattering pine, oak and fir  
timber.

10.76 Cor. No. 6, identical with cor. No. 5 of listing survey, which is a  
pine tree 14 ins. diam. I obliterate old marks and mark the tree  
6 HES 178 on side facing the claim; from which

A white oak, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 2° 00' E., 42 lks. dist.,  
marked X 6 HES 178 BT.

A white oak, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 5° 00' W., 57 lks. dist.,  
marked X 6 HES 178 BT.

Raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist.  
within the claim.

Thence I run, N. 77° 06' E. on a true line (objective cor. in sight.)  
Through undergrowth, fir, oak and pine timber. Over gently roll-  
ing land.

0.52 Trail, bears east and west.

5.68 Cor. No. 7, identical with cor No. 6 of listing survey, which is a  
white oak tree 24 ins. diam. I obliterate old marks and mark  
the tree 7 HES 178 on side facing the claim; from which

A white oak, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 69° 00' E., 37 lks. dist.,  
marked X 7 HES 178 BT.

A white oak, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 46° 15' W., 53 lks. dist.,  
marked X 7 HES 178 BT.

Raise a mound of stone 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist.  
within the claim.

August 24, 1916:- From cor. No. 7 of this survey, above described,

I run S. 85° 39' E., on a true line.

Over rolling land; through undergrowth, oak, fir and pine timber.

36.20 To cor. No. 1, the place of beginning.

from cor. No. 7, value, \$ 60.00

Approximately 1/5 mile of picket fence, value, \$ 30.00

Approximately 1/2 mile of wire fence, value \$ 40.00

Approximately 9 acres under cultivation, value, \$450.00
