CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

This claim constitutes a portion of a flat known as Caps Illihee, an old Indian camping grounds lying about 1000.ft. above North Umpqua River and approximately 1/3 mile north of it. The soil is a first rate clay loam, capable of producing all varieties of garden truck, hay and grain.

Sufficient water for domestic purposes is obtained from a well near the house.

The character of the land is non-mineral.

The nearest post office is Hoaglin, Oregon, about 28 miles by trail west of claim.

This homestead is located in approximate secs. 20 and 21, unsurveyed T. 26 S., R. 2 E., Willamette Meridian, Oregon.

Note: This approximate location is determined by protraction from U. S. G. Survey Sheet G of Plan and Profile of Umpqua River (See Water-Supply Paper 379.)
