

Homestead Entry Survey No. 182, T. 26 S., R. 2 E.

CHAINS

- 12.80 Top of spur, 110 ft. above cor. No. 2, slopes west; descend north-west slope, through fir reproduction.
- 14.77 Cor. No. 3 (40 ft. below top of ascent) identical with cor. No. 3 of listing survey, which I destroy and in its place Set a basalt stone 24x13x7 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross for cor. No. 3 of this survey, mkd. 3 HES 182 on side facing the claim, from which
- A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 39° 30' W., 43 lks. dist., marked X 3 HES 182 BT.
- A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 60° 45' E., 57 lks. dist., marked X 3 HES 182 BT.
- Raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist. within the claim.
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- Thence I run, East on a random line and at 40.70 chs. fall 65 lks. north of cor. No. 4 of listing survey. (The true bearing and length of this line is S. 89° 05' E., 40.71 chs.) Returning to cor. No. 3 of this survey, above described, I run S. 89° 05' E. on a true line. Ascend northwest slope of spur, through fir reproduction.
- 5.00 Top of spur, 100 ft. above cor. No. 3, slopes southwesterly; descend southeast slope.
- 33.00 Bottom of descent, 215 ft. below top of spur; ascend southwest slope.
- 35.80 Top of spur, 40 ft. above beginning of ascent. slopes southwesterly; descend southeast slope, through fir timber.
- 40.71 Cor. No. 4 (50 ft. below top of spur) identical with cor. No. 4 of listing survey, which I destroy, and in its place Set a conglomerate stone 26x15x7 ins., 16 ins. in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross for cor. No. 4 of this survey, mkd. 4 HES 182 on side facing the claim, from which
- A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N. 69° 45' W., 36 lks. dist., mkd. X 4 HES 182 BT.
- A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 26° 30' W., 65 lks. dist., marked X 4 HES 182 BT.
- Raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ fto dist., within the claim.
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- Thence I run, South on a random line and at 14.73 chs. fall 29 lks. east of cor. No. 1 of this survey. (the true bearing and length of this line is S. 1° 08' W., 14.73 chs.) Returning to cor. No. 4 of this survey, above described, I run S. 1° 08' W. on a true line. Along broken east slope, through fir timber.
- 9.10 Ascend northeast slope of spur, 30 ft. to
- 9.55 Top of spur, slopes eat; descend southeast slope; leave timber, enter undergrowth.
- 14.73 To cor. No. 1, the place of beginning (125 ft. below top of spur.) August 25, 1916.
- Area of H. E. S. No. 182, 60.10 acres.
