 Land Office: Roseburg, Oregon. Survey accepted March 28, 1919.

## RETRACEMENT

October 18, 1917; Preliminary to the survey of this homestead entry,  
 I make the following retracement:

From cor. No. 1 of H.E.S. No. 142, which is a fir tree, 30 ins. diam.,  
 marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of H.E.S.  
 No. 142, I run

N. 5° 45' E., (recorded bearing) retracing line 1-2 of H.E.S. No. 142

47.41 Fall 72 lks. N. 84° 15' W. of cor. No. 2 of H.E.S. No. 142, which is  
 a fir tree 28 ins. diam., marked and witnessed as described in the  
 field notes of H.E.S. No. 142. (The true bearing and length of this  
 line is N. 6° 37' E., 47.42 chs.)

Returning to cor. No. 1 of H.E.S. No. 142, above described, I run

N. 6° 37' E., on a true line, along line 1-2 of H.E.S. No. 142.

4.63 To cor. No. 1 of list No. 6-3013.

47.42 To cor. No. 2 of H.E.S. No. 142.

## H.E.S. No. 227

All listing cors. referred to herein are properly identified, being  
 marked and witnessed as described by the Forest Service in the  
 listing survey.

October 18, 1917; Beginning at point for cor. No. 1 of this survey,  
 identical with cor. No. 1 of the listing survey, which is on line  
 between cors. 1 and 2 of H.E.S. No. 142 as shown under "Retrace-  
 ment." I destroy the listing cor. and in its place establish  
 cor. No. 1 of this survey as follows:

Set a granite stone, 24x10x8 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over a  
 stone marked with a cross for cor. No. 1 of this survey, marked  
 1 HES 227 on side facing the claim, from which

A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears S. 5° 00' E., 42 lks. dist.,  
 marked X 1 HES 227 BT.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 57° 00' E., 102 lks. dist.,  
 marked X 1 HES 227 BT.

Raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist.,  
 within the claim.

U.S.L.M. No. 142, described in field notes of H.E.S. No. 93,  
 bears S. 0° 35' W., 9.80 chs. dist.

Cor. No. 1 of H.E.S. No. 142, heretofore described, bears  
 S. 6° 37' W., 4.63 chs, dist.

Thence I run, N. 6° 37' E., on a true line, along line 1-2 of H.E.S.  
 Over rolling land, through scattering fir and pine timber.

0.85 Trail, bears northwest and southeast.

1.40 Telephone line, bears north and south.

2.20 Trail, bears Northeast and southwest.

7.20 Trail, bears Northwest and southeast.
